THE ASCENSION OF JESUS

The Ascension of Jesus is the physical departure of Christ from Earth into the presence of God in Heaven. In the Christian tradition, reflected in the major Christian creeds and confessional statements, God exalted Jesus after his death, raising Him as first of the dead and taking Him to Heaven, where Jesus took his seat at the right hand of God.

In Christian art, the ascending Jesus is often shown blessing an earthly group below him, signifying the entire Church. The Feast of the Ascension is celebrated on the 40th day of Easter, always a Thursday. In Canada we celebrate the Feast of the Ascension the Sunday after the actual day of the feast.

ST. BEDE THE VENERABLE

Doctor of the Church



St. Bede was born in England about the year 673. At the age of 7 he was sent to a Benedict Monastery to be educated. Later he became a Benedict Monk. St. Bede was a most learned man of his time and a gifted writer. He wrote many historical works and beautiful biographies about the lives of Anglo-Saxon Saints. Up to the hour of his death on Ascension Day 735 this Saint was engaged in translating the Gospel of St. John from the Greek. While singing "Glory be to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Ghost" – just as he said "Holy Ghost" his soul went forth to meet his Triune God.

All-powerful God, You blessed Saint Bede by giving him the gift of writing. Help us, through his prayers, that we may recognize the gifts you have given us and help us to put them to use in your service. We ask this in the name of Jesus our Lord. Amen.

ST. PHILIP NERI



St. Philip Neri, was born in Florence, Italy in the year 1515. As child he was already known as "Pippo Buono" (good little Philip) At the age of 18 he was sent to a childless, wealthy relative to become the heir. But God had other plans for him. Guided by the Holy Spirit he soon left for Rome without money or specific plans. When in Rome, he lived in a unfurnished room spending long hours in prayer. Soon he started his "street-corner" apostolate. He encouraged passer- bys to "begin to do good" by caring for the sick, aiding the poor and enlightening the uninstructed. Directed by his confessor Philip studied for the priesthood and was ordained May 23, 1551. He laboured unceasingly for the salvation of souls and was so successful, that he was called "Apostle of Rome". St. Philip Neri enjoyed many mystical experiences. God granted him the gifts of prophecy and insight into souls. He celebrated the Holy Eucharist and heard confessions up to the last full day of his life. He died early in the morning May 26, 1595, beloved by all in Rome, where the people acclaimed him immediately a Saint. He was beatified 6 years after his death and canonized in 1623.

Let us follow St. Philip Neri's motto: If you want to be obeyed, don't make commandments. – It is easier to guide cheerful people in their spiritual life than melancholy ones. – Be good if you can.

ST. PAUL VI
Pope

Born Giovanni Battista Montini in 1897 in Italy. He was ordained in 1920 and spend years working in the Secretariat of State, In 1952 he was named Pro-Secretary of State. In 1953 Montini was appointed Archbishop of Milan. There he became known as the archbishop of the workers. In 1958 he was named Cardinal by Pope John XXIII. Pope John XXIII announced the Second Vatican Council, but died before its completion. Montini, who was well respected and on June 21 1963 was elected Pope, taking the name Paul VI. Pope Paul VI continuing the work John XXIII begun. He had to overcome resistance to implement reforms of liturgy, Church governance and attitudes towards other religions. Paul VI's papacy and writings aimed at working toward everlasting justice and peace. He promoted human rights, dignity and human development throughout the world. He believed that if you want peace you have to work for justice. Paul VI died August 6th, 1978, was beatified October 19th, 2014 and canonized October 14th, 2018 by Pope Francis.

Prayer of St. Paul VI." Make us worthy, Lord, to serve our fellowmen throughout the world who live and die in poverty and hunger. Give them through our hands, this day their daily bread, and by our understanding love, give peace and joy.
