STS. CHARLES LWANGA AND COMPANIONS

King Mtesa of Uganda allowed the White Fathers to preach the Faith in his country. However his successor, King Mwanga

initiated a fierce persecution against all Catholics. Charles Lwanga the chief of royal pages and twenty one of his companions, who had become Christians, became victims of this persecution. Charles was the first to be burned alive. By his encouraging words and his steadfast faith he left his companions an example. Twelve others followed his fate the same day the others were killed between then, June 3rd, 1886 and January 27th, 1887.These young African men were canonized by Pope Paul VI in 1964.

Father, you have made the blood of martyrs the seed of Christians. May the witness of Saint Charles Lwanga and his companions and their loyalty to Christ in the face of torture inspire countless men and women to live the Christian faith. Amen.

SAINT BONFACEBishop and Martyr, Apostle of Germany


St. Boniface was born in the year 680 in Devonshire, England and was baptized Winfrid.

From the age of 13 he was educated in the Benedictine Monastery and by 717 he was a renowned teacher and preacher. At the age of 30 he was ordained to the priesthood. . He gave up his work to answer a call to work in the mission field, which took him to Friesland, Netherlands. His first attempt was not successful and he returned to England. In 719 he went to Rome presented himself to

Pope Gregory II, and asked permission to teach the idolaters. The Pope gave him permission to teach the Faith to the heathens in Germany. The Pope also gave him the Name Boniface He established a number of dioceses in Germany, but chose Mainz as his Episcopal See. He ended his fruitful career by a glorious martyrdom in Friesland, where he had returned to teach the Faith. Legend has it that it was in Germany, after St. Boniface witnessed the worship of an oak tree by pagan people, he got angry and cut the tree down and in the oak's roots a tiny fir tree sprung. St. Boniface took it as a sign of the Christian Faith replacing pagan worship.

June 6th

ST. NORBERT Bishop





The early part of the Saint's life was devoted to the world and its pleasures. This future Apostle entered the ecclesiastical state in a worldly spirit, but was ordained subdeacon. Fear of greater restrained prevented him from receiving higher orders. Nothing short of a miracle was going to make him lead the life of an earnest cleric. An accident became this miracle, through which St. Norbert had a change of heart. While riding to a small village outside of Kanten, a stroke of lightning frightened his horse and he was thrown to the ground and knocked senseless. On regaining consciousness, he became a real penitent. He began to lead a different life. A retreat in a monastery close to Cologne completed his conversion. He prepared for the priesthood and was ordained two years later. He sold all his property and gave the proceeds to the poor. He went from place to place preaching. About 1125 he was forced into accepting the dignity of Archbishop of Magdeburg, but even with this exalted station he still practiced the same austerity he had been familiar with. His zeal effected a great reformation in the diocese. Together with St. Bernard he laboured much to extinguish the disorders caused by the schism of the Anti-Pope, Anacletus. Upon the return from a journey to Rome he fell ill. Being sick for four months he died in the year 1134.

God, You made Your Bishop Saint Norbert an outstanding minister of Your Church by his prayer and pastoral zeal. Through his prayers grant that Your faithful flock may always find pastors after Your heart and salutary pastures. Amen.
