Parents of the Virgin Mary

The Gospels tell us nothing about the parents of Mary, the grandparents of our Lord. But tradition, grounded on very old testimonies, in particular the writings of James informs us that Saints Joachim & Anne were both from the tribe of Judah of the royal house of David. In their old age they came from Galilee to settle in Jerusalem, and there the Blessed Mother of God was born and reared. Mary was probably their only child. They died and were buried in Jerusalem and a church was build on the site of their home in the 4th century, possibly by St. Helena.

Lord, God of our fathers, You gave Saint Joachim and Saint Anne the privilege of being the parents of Mary, the mother of Your incarnate Son. May their prayers help us to attain the salvation You have promised to Your people. Amen.

SAINTE MARTHA

Disciple of the Lord. Patroness of housewives, waiters and cooks



Martha was the sister of Mary and Lazarus John tells us in his Gospel, that Jesus loved them. It was Martha who received Jesus into their house and it was she who served the guests while her sister Mary sat at the Lord’s feet listening to His teaching. St. Martha is a model of hospitality. It was Martha who went to meet Jesus when he returned to Bethany to raise her dead brother Lazarus and confessed her belief that Jesus was the Christ, the Son of God. Legend tells us, that after the Ascension of Jesus, the enemies of Christianity put Martha, Mary and Lazarus aboard a ship without sails or oars. Divine Providence guided the ship to the eastern shores of France. Lazarus became Bishop of Marseilles, Mary a hermit and Martha, ever faithful to Jesus Christ, the foundress of a group of pious women performing charitable works

Father, Your Son honoured Saint Martha by coming to her home as a guest. By her prayers may we serve Christ in our brothers and sisters and be welcomed by You into heaven, our true home. Amen.



July 31st

SAINTE IGNATIUS OF LOYOLA

Patron of retreats and soldiers

Ignatius was born in 14 into an ancient noble family of Loyola in northern Spain. In his youth he served as a page to King Ferdinand of Spain and later became a brave and popular soldier in the service of the Duke of Najera, a relative of his. In summer 1521, defending the unfinished citadel of Pamplona against an invading army, Ignatius was wounded, and left him, after several operations lame. During a long convalescence, it was the Will of God, that Ignatius, having little else to do, came across the Life of Jesus and a volume of the Life of Saints. Strongly moved, he was inflamed with the desire to serve Jesus. He began a new way of life, sought shelter in the hospice of St. Lucy in Manresa, and lived a life of poverty, prayer and serving the poor. At Manresa God communicated through mystical experiences and illuminations. A spiritual fire had enkindled in Ignatius’ heart for the salvation of

souls. At the age of 33 he knew more education was necessary. Not to confine his studies to Spain alone, he went to Paris to complete his studies. He clearly saw that a new Order was needed and together with Francis Xavier, James Lainez, Peter Favre, Simon Rodriguez and others the founded the Society (Company) of Jesus, known to us as the Jesuits. 1538 Ignatius was ordained. He laboured unceasingly for the salvation of souls. In 1556, at the age of 65 he died with the words "Jesus, Jesus" in his lips. Pope Gregory XV canonized him in 1622. The Jesuit Order is important to us since it was the Jesuit missionaries that recorded our early history.

Father, You gave Saint Ignatius of Loyola to Your Church to bring greater glory to Your name. May we follow his example on earth and share the crown of life in heaven. Amen.

August 1st

SAINT ALPHONSUS LIGUORI

Patron of Theologians



St. Alphonsus was born near Naples, Italy September 27th, 1696. He was only 16 years old when he graduated in law and became a Doctor of civil law at age 17. After loosing a case in 1723, God made use of his disappointment and called him into His service. 1726 St. Alphonsus was ordained priest. 1732 he founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer, with the object of labouring for the salvation of the most abandoned souls. This became his glory and crown, but also his cross. He laboured incessantly at the work of the missions until 1756, when he was appointed Bishop of St. Agatha. In 1775 broken by age and infirmity he resigned this office to return to his convent where he died after intense suffering.

God, You constantly introduce new examples of virtue in Your Church. Walking in the footsteps of St. Alphonsus, may we be consumed with zeal for souls and attain the rewards he has won in heaven. Amen.

THE GIFT OF LIFE

Written in May 2007 by, His Grace Richard Grecco, at the time Auxiliary Bishop in Toronto,

Dear friends,

I want to share with you the attitude of John Paul II and the example of Benedict XVI regarding the medical possibility of organ and tissue donation.

"Every organ donation for the health of well-being of another is "a gesture which is a genuine act of love" writes Pope John Paul II. Obviously, he views organ and tissue donation, not merely as medical procedure but an authentic expression of Christian Charity.

When asked by a reporter if he was registered with an association of donors, Pope Benedict, then Cardinal Ratzinger responded, "Yes, I registered years ago and I always carry this document with me; in addition to personal data, it states that I offer my organs to help whoever is in need. It is simply an act of love."

Today in Ontario, more than 1700 men, women and children are waiting for a life-saving organ transplant. Every one of us, regardless of age, is a potential donor and each donor can potentially save the lives of 7 or more people.

The decision to become an organ donor is truly a family decision. When a person dies it is the decision of the family that will decide whether a donation happens or not.

From the attitude and example of Popes John Paul II and Benedict, XVI exhort families to see organ and tissue donation as an act of love and choose to help others now, by making time to speak to their beloved friends and family about their wishes and consider giving the gift of life.
