SAINT LAWRENCE

Patron of the poor and of Rome



In 257, when St. Sixtus became Pope, he ordained St. Lawrence deacon and appointed him first of the seven deacons who served in the Church of Rome. In the same year Emperor Valerian ordered that all Bishops, priests and deacons be put to death. As St. Sixtus was lead to his execution, St. Lawrence followed him. At that time he was ordered by St. Sixtus to distribute the treasures of the church among the poor. St. Lawrence did as he was commanded. And so the Church of Rome looked after fifteen hundred poor people. In 258 the Prefect of Rome ordered St. Lawrence to surrender the treasures of the Church. Three days later he exhibited the poor whom he had gathered. The enraged Prefect ordered for St. Lawrence to be slowly roasted on a gridiron. This order was merciful executed with his last breath this holy deacon prayed for the conversion of Rome. Several heathen senators, who witnessed the execution, were converted to Christianity and gave St. Lawrence a decent burial.

Father, You called Saint Lawrence to serve You by love and crowned his life with glorious martyrdom. Help us to be like him in loving You and doing Your work. Amen.

SAINT PHILOMENA

Patron of the Children of Mary

On May 25th, 1802, after about 1500 years of obscurity, in the ancient Catacomb of St. Priscilla in Rom, excavators came upon a well-preserved shelf tomb sealed in a manner usually reserved for nobility or great martyrs. The tomb was marked with tiles, which after aligning them read “Pax tecum Filumena” – which means “Peace be with you, Philomena”. Also inscribed on the tiles were the symbols of a lily, arrows, an anchor and a lance. These would indicate her virginity and martyrdom. Inside the coffin were the remains of a girl about 12 years of age and a vile with her dried blood. Her remains were transferred to the Vatican and were soon forgotten. In 1805 a Neapolitan priest requested and after a brief delay received the relics and enshrined them in his village church at Mugnano del Cardinale. Immediately after the arrival of her remains favours began to be granted and graces and miracles started to increase through her intercession. This earned her the title “Philomena, powerful with God”. Only 35 years after her exhumation Pope Gregory XVI elevated this Wonder Worker to Sainthood in the year 1837. She is the only person recognized by the Church as Saint, solely on the basis of her powerful intercessions. She is known to help in all needs. Among her most devoted clients are St. John Vianny, St. John Neumann, St. Frances Xavier Cabrini and many other Saints. A number of Popes shown remarkable devotions to St. Philomena.

We implore You, O Lord, by the intercession of Saint Philomena, Virgin and Martyr, who is ever most pleasing in Your eyes by reason of her eminent purity and the practice of all the virtues, pardon us our sins and grant us all the graces we need (here name any special grace you may require).



August 14th
SAINT MAXIMILIAN KOLBE
Patron of political prisoners and journalists

St. Maximilian was born in 1894 in Poland. He joined the Franciscans. He founded the Immaculate Movement devoted to Our Lady. Maximilian went to Japan and India to further the Movement.. In 1936 he returned home because of ill health. In 1939, after the Nazi invasion, he was imprisoned and released till he was arrested again and sent to the concentration camp at Auschwitz. There he ministered to other prisoners. On July 31, 1941, in reprisal for one prisoner's escape, ten men were chosen at random to die. Father Kolbe offered himself in place of a young husband and father. His offer was accepted. After two weeks without food and water all had died except Maximilian, so he was dragged out of his death-cell and given a lethal injection.

Lord, You inflamed St. Maximilian with love for the Immaculate Virgin and filled him with zeal for souls and love for neighbour. Through his prayers, grant that we may work strenuously for Your glory in the service of others and so be made conformable to Your Son until death. Amen.

ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY



The Church celebrates the precious death and the glorious Assumption into heaven, of Mary, the Mother of our Lord Jesus Christ. It was His Holiness Pope Pius XII who proclaimed the dogma that the Immaculate Mother of God, when the course of her life on earth was finished, was taken up into heaven body and soul. This is fitting and becoming, that she should be taken up into heaven and not lie in the grave till her Son's second coming. The dogma of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary tells us that She died because even our Lord died. Both passed through the gate of death into heaven. The humble Virgin was blessed with the crown of heaven and is seated on the throne of highest honour. She is the Queen of Angels and Saints. She is the most powerful mediator our mightiest advocate and protector of all on earth that turn to her in faith.

All-powerful and ever-living God, You raised the sinless Virgin Mary, mother of Your Son, body and soul to the glory of heaven. May we see heaven as our final goal and come to share her glory. Amen.
