SAINT GREGORY THE GREAT

Patron of Teachers

St. Gregory was born at Rome about the year 540. He was the son of a wealthy senator and after acquiring the usual thorough education, Emperor Justin the Younger appointed him Chief Magistrate of Rome, when he was only 34 years of age. After the death of his father he build six monasteries in

Sicily and a seventh in his own house in Rome. Here he himself assumed the monastic habit in 575. In 578 he was ordained deacon and was sent to Constantinople as papal ambassador. In the year of 586 he was recalled to Rome to become abbot of his monastery. 592, after the death of Pelagius, St Gregory was unanimously elected pope. He fed starving Romans, was just towards his tenants, protected the rights of Jews, his was political diplomatic and he maintained contact with all the Churches of Christendom. All this helped earn him the title "Great". St. Gregory is credited with developing the "Gregorian Chants", but this has been disputed. This great Pope died in 604. He is a Doctor of the Church.

God, You look upon Your people with compassion and rule them with love. Through the intercession of Pope St. Gregory, give wisdom to the leaders of Your Church. Amen.

September 4th

ST. ROSALIA

Patroness of Sicily

Rosalia was the daughter of Sinnibald, a descendent of the royal family of Charlemagne. From a very young age Rosalia despised worldly honours. She might have become a Basilian nun,



but later lived as a recluse in a cave on Mount Pelegrino, about five kilometers from Palermo. She lived there for 16 years practicing austere penances whilst her soul was constantly united to God in prayer. Rosalia died on September 4th, 1160 and was buried in a grotto under the mountain forgotten by the world. I was not till the 17th century that her body was found again. It is claimed that it was St. Rosalia intercession that saved Sicily from the plague in 1625. Pope Urban VIIII enrolled her in the Roman Martyrology. Numerable cures have occurred at her shrine. Pope Pius XI raised her feast day to the rank of a holy day of obligation in Palermo. There the citizens celebrate her feast day by carrying the Saint's shrine in procession on top of a large carriage drawn by forty mules while prayers and hymns are sung in honour of St. Rosalia. She is not just venerated in Palermo, her native city, but throughout Sicily, of which she is patroness.



September 5th

SAINT MOTHER TERESA OF CALCUTTA

Gonxha (Agnes) Bojaxhill, lovingly known to the world as Mother Teresa of Calcutta, was born August 26th, 1910 in Skopje, Macedonia. Her parents Nikola and Drane were of Albanian decent. Gonxha

received first Holy Communion at the age of five and a half and was confirmed 3 months after her 6th birthday. When eight years of age her father died. Drane raised her children firmly and lovingly and influenced her daughter's vocation. In September 1918 Gonxha left to follow God's call to become a missionary. She joined the Sisters of Loreto in Dublin, Ireland. There she received the name "Teresa' after the little Flower St. Therese. After a few months of training in Dublin she departed for India and arrived in Calcutta on January 6th, 1929. She was assigned to teach at St. Mary's School for girls. Sister Teresa made her First Profession of Vows in May 1931 and her Final Profession of Vows on May 24th, 1937, becoming, as she said, the spouse of Jesus for all eternity. Twenty years she taught with deep love for her religious sisters and her students. In 1946 traveling by train from Calcutta to Darjeeling for her annual retreat, by that time known as "Mother Teresa" she received her "call within a call". She never explained how, Jesus revealed to her His pain at the neglect of the poor and that He wanted her to establish a religious community to look after the poor, sick and unwanted. With permission, Mother Teresa established the Missionaries of Charity. On August 17th, 1948, she dressed for the first time in a white, blue-bordered sari and left her beloved Loreto convent to go and be with the poorest of the poor. 1950 the new congregation of Missionaries of Charity was officially established in the Archdiocese of Calcutta. 1965 Pope Paul VI granted the Decree of Praise to the congregation and encouraged Mother Teresa to establish houses all over the world. She received, besides many other prizes, the Nobel Peace prize in 1970, which she received "for the glory of God and in the name of the poor". In 1997 the Sisters of Charity numbered 4000 members, in 610 houses were established in 123 countries all over the world. Mother Teresa's earthly life came to an end September 5th, 1997. She was beatified by Pope John Paul II in October 2003.
