SAINT MARGARET OF SCOTLAND

Patroness of Scotland



St. Margaret, a grandniece of Edward the Confessor, was born about 1045 in Hungary. She was the daughter of Edward Atheling, heir apparent to the English throne and a Hungarian princess. At the age of ten Margaret was brought his family back to England, but the were forced back into exile in 1066. In 1070 St. Margaret married Malcolm III, King of Scotland. They had 8 children. St. Margaret devoted her life to the religious upbringing of them and worked for justice and improved conditions for the poor. She guided the church toward strong ties with Rome. She founded several churches and led a live of prayer and devout practices.

God, You endowed St. Margaret with a wonderful love for the poor. Through her intercession and example, make us so generous that all people may see in us the image of Your goodness. Amen.

SAINT ELIZABETH OF HUNGARY

St. Elizabeth was born in Hungary in 1207, the daughter of Alexander II, King of Hungary. At the age of 4 she was sent for her education to the court of the Landgrave of Thuingia to whose son she was betrothed. In 1221, at the age of 14 she married Louis, her betrothed. In spite of her position at court she lead a simple life, practiced penance and devoted herself to work of charity. Her husband, himself a religious man, encouraged and supported her in her good works. They had three children, when Louis was killed while on Crusade. Elizabeth left the court, made arrangements for the care of the children and in 1228 entered the Third Order of St. Francis. She build a hospital in Marburg and devoted herself to the care of the sick until her death at the age of 24 in 1231.

Father, You helped St. Elizabeth to recognize and serve Christ in the poor. Grant, through her intercession, that we may always lovingly serve the needy and oppressed. Amen.

DEDICATION OF THE BASILICAS OF SAINTS PETER AND PAUL

The Basilica of St Peter on Vatican Hill and that of St. Paul were erected by Constantine in the 4th century on the site of the martyrdom of these two Apostles. These Basilicas were consecrated by St. Sylvester on November 18th. The Basilica of St Peter is on the site of the circus of Nero. Beneath its High Altar rest the sacred remains of St. Peter, the Chief of the Apostles. The Basilica of St. Paul Outside-the-Walls was build over the tomb of St. Paul, the Apostle of the Gentiles. It was almost completely destroyed by fire in 1823, but was rebuild on a grander scale by Popes Gregory XVI and Pius IX. and consecrated by the latter December 10, 1854. Pope Pius the XI instituted this feast under the original date of November 18th.

PRESENTATION OF THE VIRGIN MARY

Tradition tells us that the Blessed Virgin Mary was vowed to God by her parents. At the age of 3 she was taken by them to the Temple to be educated and to live in the precincts of the Temple with other Jewish girls and holy women who cared for them. During the years of Mary's service in the Temple, her pure soul was adorned with the most precious graces. This offering and dedication of the Blessed Virgin to the Lord, the Church commemorates today.

Let us pray. Today, as we celebrate the glorious memory of the most holy Virgin Mary, grant, O Lord, that through her intercession we too may receive many graces from Your abundant bounty. Amen.
