THE MOST HOLY NAME OF JESUS

The name of Jesus is honoured and revered since the beginning of Christianity, because Jesus is Lord in heaven and earth. St. Paul writes that “at the name of Jesus every knee should bend”. The monogram of the name of Jesus HIS (from the Greek IHSOUS) can be traced to the 8th century, but was widely promoted in the 15th century by St. John Capistrano and Bernardine of Siena. Believers are exhorted to bow their heads in reverence at the mention of the most Holy Name of Jesus.

O God, You appointed Your only-begotten Son to be the Saviour of mankind, and You commanded His Name to be called Jesus. Mercifully grant that we may enjoy the vision of Him in heaven, who’s holy Name we venerate on earth. Amen.
