February 2nd
THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD
This feast is also known as the Purification of the Blessed Virgin, and also Candlemas Day.

Forty days after His birth, Jesus was brought to the Temple of Jerusalem by Mary and Joseph and was presented to the Lord, as the law of Moses required.

Almighty and ever-living God, on this day Your only Son was presented in the Temple as sharing in our human nature. We humbly ask that we too may be presented to You with purified intentions. Amen.



February 3rd
SAINT BLAISE
Bishop, Martyr, Patron of those with throat diseases, wool-combers and wild animals.

Virtually nothing is known with certainty about St. Blaise. It is believed, that he studied philosophy and later became a physician. In his profession as physician he witnessed many miseries of life and resolved to spend his life in God's service. Known is that, after the death of the Bishop of Sebaste, in Armenia, St. Blaise was appointed bishop. Legend has it that in order to escape persecution under Licinius he took refuge in a cave and lived with wild animals, which he cured of various ailments. St. Blaise was found, seized and taken to prison to be interrogated. On his way to prison a mother, whose child suffered from a disease of the throat implored his aid. At his intercession the child was cured. It is said that St. Blaise promised that anyone who lit a taper in his memory would be free of infection. (Hence the two tapers in the form of a cross when the priest blesses throats) According to legend St. Blaise had been put to death by having his flesh torn by metal wool combs and so died a martyr's death.

Lord, hear Your people through the intercession of Saint Blaise. Help us to enjoy peace in this life and find a lasting refuge in the next. Amen.



February 5th
SAINT AGATHA
Virgin & Martyr. Patroness of Nurses, Miners and Alpine Guides.

Legend tells us that St. Agatha, a Sicilian virgin of noble birth, was martyred at Catania in 251 during the Decian persecution for refusing the solicitations of a Roman Senator. St. Agatha was subjected to the most cruel tortures. When she continued to resist, she was thrown upon red-hot coals. At this point a violent earthquake shook the town. Agatha was returned to prison, where she died of her tortures, after the Apostle St. Peter supposedly appeared to her. Her intervention is credited with stilling the eruption of Mount Etna the year after her burial.

Lord God, Saint Agatha always pleased You by her chastity and in the end by her martyrdom. May she obtain for us merciful pardon for our sins. Amen.

SAINTS PAUL MIKI AND COMPANIONS

Martyrs



In 1597, forty-five years after St. Francis Xavier had evangelized much of Japan, St. Paul Miki and twenty-five others were martyred. Those martyred were three Japanese Jesuits: Paul Miki, John Goto, James Kisai;

Six Franciscans, four of whom were Spanish: Peter Baptist, Martin de Aguirre, Francis Blanco, Francis of St. Michael; one Mexican: Philip de las Casas; and one Indian: Gonsalo Garcia; the other seventeen were Japanese lay people, including a soldier, physician and altar boys. All were pierced with a lance like their Saviour.

God our Father, grant us through their intercession, the courage to be loyal to our Faith until our death. Amen.
