SAINT VALENTINE

Priest and Martyr. Patron of Greetings.



St. Valentine and St. Marius assisted the martyrs of Rome who suffered during the reign of Emperor Claudius II. St. Valentine was apprehended in the year 270 and was sent to the Prefect of Rome, who commanded that he be beaten with clubs and afterward be beheaded.

The connection between St. Valentine's feast day and lovers most likely came about because of the takeover by Christians of the Roman practice, consisting of boys drawing names of girls to honour the goddess Februa Juno.

SAINT JULIANA

Virgin, Martyr



St. Juliana, a native of Cumae Italy, was born in the third century into a house in which her father worshiped statues of Roman gods. Juliana herself knew believed in the one true God and in Jesus in whom she believed with all her heart and soul and committed her life to Him. She, true to the teachings of Jesus, shared her wealth with fellow Christians. When Juliana turned 18 her father gave her to Eleusius, Prefect of Cumae, to be married. She had no objection to this union in the believe she could convert her fiancée to the Christian Faith. She confided in him that she herself is a Christian, but her betrothed betrayed her and told her father. Her father tried to persuade to leave her Faith and worship his gods. When she refused her father handed her over to be beaten with rods and burned with boiling lead. Then he had her shackled, chained and thrown into a dungeon. There, at midnight, an angel appeared to her telling her to worship the Roman gods. When she prayed to her God, He showed her the true nature of the "angel" and told her to fight him. Miraculous her chains broke and Satan was chained. In the morning she showed the winged devil to the guards telling them that this is what their gods are like. (Today St. Juliana is pictured with a winged devil, which she leads on a chain.) That very day she was condemned to death. She was beheaded and so earned he crown of Martyrdom. It was the year 304

ASH WEDNESDAY

Ash Wednesday probably dates from at least the eighth century and occurs forty days before Easter. Even though Ash Wednesday is not a day of obligation, practicing Catholics will attend Mass. On this day the faithful, according to ancient custom, approach the altar where the priest, dipping his thumb into previously blessed ashes, marks the forehead of each with the sign of the cross, saying the words: "Remember, mortal, you are dust and to dust you will return" or "Turn away from sin and be faithful to the Gospel". The ashes used in this ceremony are made by burning palms, which were blessed on Palm Sunday of the previous year, when we commemorated Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem by waving palms. And so by using these palms, we should remember that we must not only rejoice in Jesus' coming but also regret the fact that our sinfulness made it necessary for Him to die for us in order to save us from eternal condemnation. The reception of this sacramental, is full with symbolism of penance. All through the books of Law, both Old and New, men who repented their sins covered themselves with or sat in ashes and clothed themselves with sackcloth. For us too, getting signed with the cross of ashes, is the acknowledgement of our sinfulness and need of repentance.

The word Lent derived from the old English word "lencten" which literally means, "Spring". During the season of spring everything is made new. New life begins and so we too should

begin anew. How? Let it be the springtime of the soul, a time to make a new covenant with God. Let us develop close relationship with our Creator and discover what God is asking of us. We can look to Jesus, who taught with authority because He taught by example and what did He do? Jesus went into the desert, away from all the excitement of daily life, for forty days. These forty days Jesus spent in prayer and fasting. If Jesus who was without sin prayed and fasted for forty days, how much more do we sinners need to do the same. Hence the Church gives us forty days to prepare ourselves to be worthy to take part in Jesus' joyous resurrection. Forty days to seek some quiet time, time we can spend in prayer. Prayer will help us with fasting. Fasting is not just less eating and drinking, fasting means also to stay away from things that we enjoy. This might make us more aware of the less fortunate all around us. Remember Jesus loved the poor and sick. During Lent we should do some "spring-cleaning" and so the Church tells us to clean our hearts and souls by going to confession. On Ash Wednesday we acknowledged that we are sinners, confession cleanses us from our sins. We should look on this season of Lent as another opportunity in which to become more faithful followers of our Lord Jesus Christ.
