This is the night, most blessed of all nights, chosen by God to see Christ rising from the dead. Alleluia.

PASSION OR PALM SUNDAY

We commemorate the triumphant entry of Jesus unto Jerusalem. We see Jesus, our King, humbly riding the foal of a donkey, a beast of burden, to fulfill what the prophet Zechariah had spoken. "Rejoice heartily, 0 daughter Zion,



shout for joy, 0 daughter Jerusalem! See, your king shall come to you; a just savior is he, meek, and riding on an ass, on a colt, the foal of an ass." (Zec 9:9-10) A large crowd took off their cloaks and laid them on the road. Others cut branches from trees and spread them on Jesus' path. Men, women and children lined the road Jesus traveled on. Others ran ahead of Jesus or followed Him, but all of them cried out: "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest heaven!" Today we still use these words at Mass. How fickle we humans are! How fast we turned on our Saviour and screamed "Crucify Him!" We do so every time we sin.

THE LAST SUPPER

As the coming of Christ was foretold by the prophets and even by secular writers of that time, so was the purpose of His coming revealed. Isaiah prophesied that Christ would suffer for us because of our sins. (Is. 53:4ff.) By

His suffering and death, Christ offered Himself to reconcile us to God the Father. Christ knew He would soon die and return to the Father. But he left a mystery of love, His presence among us to be our continuing gift of Himself. He did this at the Last Supper, which He ate with His disciples; He wished us to remember Him. It was then He took bread and wine, simple elements of food, and declared that these when consecrated by priests would become His Body, His Blood, ever present to us. It is this Presence, this consecrated divine food, which we celebrate in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. It is this Presence, this Eucharistic Gift of Christ given to us again and again, whereby we eat of Him and remember His Presence leading us to worship God. It is the beginning now of joy that will be ours forever. Christ gave Himself at the Last Supper, and when He gives Himself to us in every renewal of His Presence, He gives the most sacred and wonderful Gift that He could bestow upon us. Everyone should gratefully welcome this Gift throughout the months as we receive Christ again and again into our hearts; the continuing of Christ's precious Gift, His sacramental Presence ever before us and within us.

Isaiah prophesied that Christ would suffer for us because of our sins. By His suffering and death, Christ offered Himself to reconcile us to God the Father. We could not return to God unless Christ came to earth to become a sacrifice for us as Isaiah said. Christ, our heavenly Gift to us, won



for us grace and reconciliation with God the Father. It was Christ's death, the human destruction, of our gift from God that won for us the assurance of hope. It seems a sad and terrible way for us to regain the ability to attain our promised reward. Christ said, "Take up your cross and follow me." It is difficult for us to bear the hardships of life. But if we follow Christ, if we offer ourselves with

Christ, we learn to transform the sacrifices and sorrows of life into pathways that lead to God. Without Christ's suffering and willing death on the Cross we could not fulfill the command of love and return to God the Father. This we remember gratefully and offer to God in the Sacrifice of the Mass. Christ gave to His Apostles the authority, the teaching that would make certain the eternal purpose of His coming. He said to His Apostles: "Teach them to carry out everything I have commanded you. And know that I am with you always, until the end of the world." Christ, our gift of grace and salvation, remains with us because out of love this Saviour died for us. He is our living God.

Our faith, and recognition of the great Gift of Christ in our lives, is proven by His resurrection from the realm of the dead. Christ rose again and came to us as He had come to us at His birth. Christ opened up to us the kingdom of God by His death, and by His resurrection He gave us the assured faith that we may return to God. We have assurance

because of the resurrection of Christ that we also will arise. We can think upon this with joy. We can anticipate this with confidence, as we pray and strive to fulfill the will of God. We should live with great confidence for our courage is based on Christ. St. Luke tells us: "Do not live in fear, little flock. It has pleased your Father to give you the kingdom."By Christ's coming to earth, by His sacrifice of Himself, we are renewed in the joy of someday possessing the eternal kingdom of life and love that God promised us from the beginning. May we always in our daily living praise and give glory to Go through our generous cooperation with His gift of Himself and His graces.


