SAINT GEORGE

Martyr, Patron of England and other European Countries the Boy Scouts and soldiers.



There is not much known about the life of St. George. We do know that devotions to him can be traced to at least the 5th century, but might have been much earlier if it can be proved that St. George church, one of the oldest churches in Constantinople, was built by Constantine the Great. It is supposed that St. George suffered persecution and martyrdom for his faith under the Diocletian at Nicomedia in the beginning of the 3rd century.

St. George is believed to have been a soldier in the Roman army and was involved in the organization of a Christian community in, what is now Iran. In Greece, St. George is called the "Great Martyr" and his feast day is kept as holy day of obligation..

It is supposed that it was St. George who tore down the imperial edicts of persecution in Nicomedia. He is usually shown in combat with a dragon, who might represent the evil one. During the reign of Edward III he was made patron of the kingdom.

Lord, we acclaim Your might and humble pray.. Just as St. George imitated the Lord's Passion, so let him now come to the aid in our weakness. Amen.

EMMAUS

Since that day of Christ's resurrection, when the world found its own newborn gift of faith, we all have wanted to keep Christ close to us. While other worldly gifts are out-grown, forgotten or broken, God's gift of Himself to each of us remains and is increased as we respond to Him.

It was to show this fact that Christ walked with two of His disciples on the roadway to Emmaus after His resurrection. He joined them as they walked, but they did not recognize Him. He appeared to be just another traveler, going in the same direction. While discussing the recent events that had startled all of Jerusalem, they discovered that He was full of knowledge, impressive in what He talked about and explained to them. He was so clearly well-informed that they invited Him to continue the conversation and have dinner with them. They still thought of Him as only a stranger along the road.

But when they began to eat the dinner set before them, they recognized Him. "They had come to know Him in the breaking of bread," St. Luke tells us. (Lk. 24:35) They suddenly knew Him in His real Presence as we know Christ when we receive the Sacrament of the Eucharist.

The disciples learned more about Christ in His next appearance to them when He wished them "peace" (Lk. 24:36) and taught them, opening their minds to the truths of the Scriptures. Throughout our lives, may we also come to know Him better and love Him more.
