ST.ZITA

Virgin, Patroness of domestic workers.

St. Rita was born in the early thirteenth century in Monte Sagrati into a very devout, but poor family. Her uncle, a Hermit was regarded by the local people

a Saint. An older sister became a Cisterian nun. Rita showed a strong obedience to God's will . At the age of twelve she became a domestic servant in the house of a well to do weaver in Luca. She stayed with this family for 48 years. She carried out her household duties efficiently and found time for daily Holy Mass and recite her plentiful prayers. She thought of her domestic work a part of her religion. At first her employers were not pleased when St. Zita gave food to the poor, but in time were won over and even gave her freedom over her working schedule to give her time to visit the sick and those in prison. St. Zita became known in Luca for her goodness and the magnifications that appeared to her.. At St. Zita's passing the people acclaimed her a Saint. Pope Innocence III canonized her in 1696.

Lord God, You showered heavenly gifts on St. Zita, the Virgin. Help us to imitate her virtues during our earthly life and enjoy eternal happiness with her in heaven. Amen

SAINT CATHERINE OF SIENA

Doctor of the Church, Co-Patroness of Europe

St. Catherine was born in the year 1347 in Siena, Italy. She was the twenty-fifth, and last child born to her parents, At an early age she, against her parents'



wishes, consecrated her virginity to God. In 1365 she received the Habit of the third Order of St. Dominic. She spent years in seclusion fasting and praying. In 1374, during the great pestilence, she devoted herself to the care of the infected. St. Catherine corresponded with Cardinals, Princes and Popes seeking to avert

terrible evil, She was a renowned peacemaker St. Catherine is well known for her spiritual reflection. She died in Rome, was canonized in 1461 by Pope Pius II and was named patron of Italy in 1939. In 1970 Pope Paul VI named her co-patron of Europe.

Oh God, You caused St. Catherine to shine with Divine love in contemplation of the Lord's Passion and in the service of your Church. By her help, grant that your people associated in the mystery of Christ, may ever exult in the revelation of His glory. Amen
