ST. JOHN I
Pope, Martyr



A native of Tuscany, Italy, John was elected Pope while he was still an archdeacon to succeed Pope Hormisdas, who died 523. That year Emperor Justin I of Constantinople issued an edict against Arian heretics. Italy was ruled by an Arian, Theodoric the Goth, who was angered upon hearing what had happened to his brothers in faith and reversed his policy of tolerance towards the Catholic Faith. 525 Theodoric summoned Pope John I to Ravenna and ordered him to go to Constantinople to induce emperor Justin to withdraw his edict against the Arians. Constantinople welcomed Pope John I, but not as ambassador from Theodoric, but as head of Christianity. Theodoric was not happy with the outcome of the mission and imprisoned all members of the delegation upon their return including Pope John I., who died May 18th, 526, as a result of the treatment he experienced there.

God, the rewarder of those faithful to You, hear the prayers of your people and through the intercession of St. John I, help us to always be constant in our Faith. Amen.



May 20th

ST. BERNARDINE OF SIENA
Priest

St. Bernardine lovingly called the "Apostle of Italy", was born September 8th, 1380 of a noble family at Massa, of which his father was governor. Left an orphan at six Bernardine was brought up with great care by his pious aunts. His youth was blameless and engaging. He studied civil and canon law, joined the Confraternity of Our Lady attached to the great hospital of Santa Maria della Scala, where, during an outbreak of the plague, he ministered to the sick and encouraged other men to do so. On becoming a priest, he was commissioned to preach He instituted the feast of the Holy Name of Jesus. An excellent preacher he won converts all over Italy. He refused 3 bishoprics, but took on the position of vicar general of the Franciscans. He died May 20th, 1444.

God, You gave St. Bernardine, Your Priest an exceeding love for the Name of Jesus Through his merits and prayers grant that we may ever be inflamed with love for You. Amen.

May 22nd

SAINT RITA OF CASCIA
Widow, Patroness of Impossible Cases.



St. Rita was born at Spoleto, Italy in 1381. From an early age, Rita begged her parent to allow her to enter a convent, but her parents betrothed her to a cruel man with a violent temper, whom she married at the age of 18. Rita became a good wife and mother of twin sons. She was often mistreated by her husband, who taught their children his own evil ways. Rita prayed for her family. After almost 20 years of marriage, her husband was stabbed and died, but not before he repented. Rita's prayers were heard. Her twin sons were determined to avenge their father's death an again Rite appealed to heaven to prevent such a crime. Her prayers were answered and her two sons died before committing a crime,

reconciled to God. After the death of her sons, she was alone in this world, she filled her days with good works, prayer, fasting and penance till she, after being initially refused, was finally admitted to the Augustinian convent at Cascia, Umbria, where she lived for 40 years a life of perfect obedience and great charity. Having great devotion to the Passion of Christ, she asked to be allowed to suffer like Jesus. She was struck by one of the thorns from the crucifix on the forehead. This wound would not heal and did cause her much suffering till she died on May 22nd, 1457. After many miracles were attributed to her intercessions, she was canonized May 24th 1900.

God, through the prayers of St. Rita, may we learn to bear our crosses in life in the same spirit in which she bore hers. Amen.
