MOST HOLY TRINITY



In Trinitarian doctrine, God exists as three persons, but is one being, having a single divine nature. The members of the Trinity are co-equal and co-eternal, one in essence, nature, power, action, and will. The Father is uncreated, the Son is uncreated, and the Holy Spirit is uncreated, and all three are eternal without beginning. "The Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit" are not names for different parts of God, but one name for God because three persons exist in God as one entity. They cannot be separated from one another. Each person is understood as having the identical essence or nature, not merely similar natures

Baptism is generally conferred with the Trinitarian formula, "in the name of the father, and of the son, and of the holy spirit".

VISITATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY

This feast commemorates the visit of the Blessed Virgin Mary to St. Elizabeth. At the time when Angel Gabriel told Mary, that she will conceive by the Holy Spirit, he also told her that her aged cousin, who was said to be barren, is expecting. Mary went to see Elizabeth and the two women, both with child, met. At this meeting the child in Elizabeth's womb, John the Baptist, leaped for joy. Elizabeth, filled with the Holy Spirit recognized Mary as the Mother of God, and asked: "Why is it that the mother of my Lord comes to me." Part of St. Elizabeth's proclamation we use even today, whenever we pray the Hail Mary.



Eternal Father, You inspired the Virgin Mary, mother of Your Son, to visit Elizabeth and assist her in her need. Keep us open to the working of Your Spirit, and with Mary may we praise You for ever. Amen.

SAINT ANGELA MERICI

Patron of one of our Elementary Schools



St. Angela Merici was born in Desenzano, Lombardy, Italy on March 21st, 1474. At the age of eleven she was left orphaned. From an early age she lived a very holy life, trying to please Jesus, the spouse of her soul. When her sister met with sudden death, without receiving the Last Sacraments, Angela was deeply distressed. She increased her prayers for the repose of her sister's soul. Imploring God to reveal to her the state of her sister, she was shown a vision that her sister was with the Saints in Heaven. When Angela was twenty years of age she converted paternal home into a school, where she instructed young girls in the Christian religion. She recognized that disorders of society were caused, because the education of young girls was neglected. In 1524 she went on a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. On the island of Crete she suddenly became blind, but continued her journey. On the way back she prayed before a Crucifix at the same place where she became blind a few weeks before and received her sight back. During the jubilee year 1525 she traveled to Rome to gain indulgences. Pope Clement VII, having heard of her holiness and

success as teacher in religion, invited Angela to remain in Rome, but she, shunning publicity, returned to Brescia. On the 25th of November 1535 Angela chose 12 virgins and laid the foundation of the Ursuline Order. This Orders object being the Christian education of youth, which she placed under the patronage of St. Ursula, patron of virgins. After serving 5 years as Superior, of the new Order, she died 1540 with the name of Jesus on her lips. 1807 Pope Pius VII added her name to the calendar of Saints.

STS. CHARLES LWANGA AND COMPANIONS



King Mtesa of Uganda allowed the White Fathers to preach the Faith in his country. However his successor, King Mwanga initiated a fierce persecution against all Catholics. Charles Lwanga the chief of royal pages and twenty one of his companions, who had become Christians, became victims of this persecution. Charles was the first to be burned alive. By his encouraging words and his steadfast faith he left his companions an example. Twelve others followed his fate the same day the others were killed between then, June 3rd, 1886 and January 27th, 1887. These young African men were canonized by Pope Paul VI in 1964.

Father, you have made the blood of martyrs the seed of Christians. May the witness of Saint Charles Lwanga and his companions and their loyalty to Christ in the face of torture inspire countless men and women to live the Christian faith. Amen.

SAINT BONFACE

Bishop and Martyr, Apostle of Germany



St. Boniface was born in the year 680 in Devonshire, England and was baptized Winfrid. From the age of 13 he was educated in the Benedictine Monastery and by 717 he was a renowned teacher and preacher. At the age of 30 he was ordained to the priesthood. He gave up his work to answer a call to work in the mission field, which took him to Friesland, Netherlands. His first attempt was not successful and he returned to England. In 719 he went to Rome presented himself to Pope Gregory II, and asked permission to teach the idolaters. The Pope gave him permission to teach the Faith to the heathens in Germany. The Pope also gave him the Name Boniface He established a number of dioceses in Germany, but chose Mainz as his Episcopal See. He ended his fruitful career by a glorious martyrdom in Friesland, where he had returned to teach the Faith.

Legend has it that it was in Germany, after St. Boniface witnessed the worship of an oak tree by pagan people, he got angry and cut the tree down and in the oak's roots a tiny fir tree sprung. St. Boniface took it as a sign of the Christian Faith replacing pagan worship.

Lord, let St. Boniface intercede for us, that we may be loyal to the Faith he taught and for which he shed his blood. Give us also the courage to fearlessly profess our faith in our
