ASSUMPTION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY



The Church celebrates the precious death and the glorious Assumption of Mary, the Mother of our Lord Jesus Christ, into heaven. It was His Holiness Pope Pius XII who proclaimed the dogma that the Immaculate Mother of God, when the course of her life on earth was finished, was taken up into heaven body and soul.

The dogma of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary tells us that She died because even our Lord died. Both passed through the gate of death into heaven. The humble Virgin was blessed with the crown of heaven and is seated on the throne of highest honour.

All-powerful and ever-living God, You raised the sinless Virgin Mary, mother of Your Son, body and soul to the glory of heaven. May we see heaven as our final goal and come to share her glory. Amen.

SAINT STEPHEN Patron of Hungary



St. Stephen was born in 977 at Gran, then the capital of Hungary. His father Geza, third duke of the Magyars and his mother Sarboth, had both converted to Christianity. They and St. Stephen were baptized when he was about 10 years of age. In 997, after his father's death, he inherited his dukedom. The work of propagating the Faith went on with vigor. Churches, monasteries and Bishopsrics were founded; he saw to it that Hungarians were trained as priests. Stephen, sent his intended first archbishop Astrik to Rome to obtain the confirmation of his foundations from Pope Silvester II. In order to gratify the wish of his subjects, he asked for, and was granted, the title of King. The Pope had a crown made, and with this crown St. Stephen was crowned king in 1001. Stephen was a committed Christian, had a great love for Our Lady, was generous distributing alms in person. He died in 1038 and his relics are enshrined in the church of Our Lady in Buda.

Almighty God, Your Church flourished through the efforts of St. Stephen when he reigned on earth. Grant that she may now be defended by him, who is dwelling gloriously in heaven. Amen.

August 18th

ST. HELENA



It is generally believed by ecclesiastical historians that St. Helena was born in England, daughter of Coel, a British King who lived in friendship with the Romans. St. Helena did not embrace the Christian Faith till after her son Constantine's miraculous victory in 312, when he entered Rome as emperor. She practiced her new religion to perfection. She used her wealth in charity to the poor and for building churches. It was her influence that ended the

persecution of Christianity in the Roman Empire. When her son, Constantine was determined to build a church on Mount Calvary, St. Helena at 80 years of age, undertook to see the work executed. She went to Jerusalem hoping to find the Holy Cross. During excavations three crosses were discovered. The title found near the crosses and perhaps the marks of the nails by which it had been attached, seemed to indicate which was the Cross of the Saviour. St. Helena build two magnificent churches, one on Mount Calvary, the other on Mount Olive. She returned to Rome where she died about 329

Lord Jesus Christ, You willed to enrich Your Church through St. Helena with a treasure beyond price and so revealed to her the hiding place of Your Cross. Through her intercession, grant that the ransom paid on that life-giving wood may win the rewards of everlasting life for us. Amen.
