SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL
Priest, Patron of Charitable Societies



St. Vincent was born of poor parents in Gascony, France about 1580. He enjoyed his first schooling under Franciscan Fathers and made great progress. He was hired as tutor and this enabled him to continue his studies without burdening his parents. He studied to become a priest and was ordained in 1600. In 1605 on a voyage by sea he fell into the hands of pirates and was taken as slave to Tunis, where he was for two years before he could escape. After being in Rome he returned to France, where he became a preacher, but charity became his predominant virtue. St. Vincent de Paul died at the age of 80 in the year 1660.

God, You gave Vincent de Paul the courage and holiness of an apostle for the well-being of the poor and the formation of the clergy. Help us to be zealous in continuing his work. Amen.

SAINTS MICHAEL, GABRIEL & RAPHAEL
Archangels

Angels are spirits without bodies, with a mind and a will. They were created by God to adore Him, act as His messengers and guardians of human beings.



ST. MICHAEL, whose name means "Who is like God?", which was the war cry of the good angels in the battle fought in heaven against Satan and his followers. He is recognized as the leader of the forces of heaven in their triumph over the powers of hell. St. Michael is the protector of the Church of Jesus Christ and Patron of Policemen.

ST. GABRIEL The name Gabriel means "God has shown Himself mighty". St. Gabriel was the angel that announced to Zachariah the birth of John the Baptist and to the Virgin Mary that she will conceive through the Holy Spirit the Son of God. Communicating with us humans he is the Patron of Communication Workers



ST. RAPHAEL who's name means "God heals" is mostly known to us through the book of Tobit, whom he healed of blindness. He is Patron of Travelers.
