ALL SOULS



On this day we commemorate all the Faithful Departed. The reason for this commemoration is the doctrine and belief that all who die in venial sin, or have not fully atoned for other transgressions are detained in purgatory to be cleansed of all impurities. We can help them through their temporal punishment and hasten their admission into heaven and into the presence of God, by our prayers, especially by the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

November 3rd

SAINT MARTIN DE PORRES

Patron of social justice and of people of mixed race.

Martin de Porres was born at Lima, Peru in 1579. His father was a Spanish knight and his mother an Indian woman from Panama. As half-casts he and his sister did not enjoy full privileges. At 15 Martin became a lay-brother at the Dominican Friary. His great desire was to go to some foreign mission, since this was not possible, he devoted his live to the care of the sick and the poor, and of animals (He maintained a hospital for animals at his sister's home) Because of his great wisdom his advice was sought by people in high places. He was loved and respected all who knew him. St. Rose of Lima was a close friend of his. St. Martin was canonized May 6th, 1962.

God, You led St. Martin by the way of humility to heavenly glory. Help us to follow the example of his holiness and so become worthy to be exalted with him in heaven. Amen.

November 4th

SAINT CHARLES BORROMEIO

Patron of catechists and catechumens and of Seminarians

St. Charles Borromeo was born in 1538 at Arona. If ever the gates of hell could have prevailed it was at this time. It was the time of the Catholic Reformation. Charles was born into a aristocratic family. His father, Count Gilbert Borromeo, possessed great piety and rare diplomatic abilities. It was from him Charles learned his love of prayer and tender care for the



poor. His mother was Margaret de Medici, sister of Cardinal de Medici, who became Pope Pius IV. Charles, encouraged by his father to wear the cassock, was sent to Milan to pursue his studies. There one of his masters remarked, that Charles will be the great reformer and will do wonderful things. At the age of 22 his uncle Pope Pius IV created him Cardinal-Archbishop of Milan Pope and shortly afterwards nominated him Archbishop of Milan and Papal Secretary of State. He dedicated his life with great personal sacrifice. Imposing much needed severe discipline on both clergy and laity provoked opposition. For merely honorary positions he had no ambition. In the great plague at Milan in 1575 he showed himself the true shepherd by his self-sacrificing charity. Charles died in 1584 and was canonized in 1610. His motto was: Be sure you preach by the way you live.

Father, keep in Your people the spirit which filled Charles Borromeo. Let your Church be continually renewed and show the unity of Christ to the world by being conformed to his likeness.
