EPIPHANY

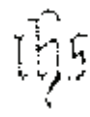


Epiphany, a Greek word, meaning "Appearance or manifestation", is the Feast of the Manifestation of the Child Jesus to the Gentiles. Jesus, the Word made flesh on Christmas day, was known to only a few. To Mary and Joseph, to the shepherds and to their friend who would believe. He was hidden from the world. Three Magi, gentiles, had seen a star and without hesitation were ready to follow call of the newborn King of the Jews. Doubts as to the meaning of the star and complaints about the great distance found no place in their hearts or minds. When they found the Child Jesus prostrated themselves and presented Jesus with gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh Gold for His kingship on earth, frankincense for His kingship in heaven and myrrh for Christ is the Healer and Saviour of the world. In revealing Himself to the Three Wise Men He revealed Himself to all gentiles.

Father, You revealed Your Son to the nations by the guidance of a star. Lead us to Your glory in heaven by the light of faith. Amen.

MOST HOLY NAME OF JESUS

SAINT ANDRE BESSETTE



Blessed Andre was born near Quebec in 1845. Because of poor health he did not attend school regularly and could not read or write. Andre entered the Congregation of the Holy Cross as a Brother and was assigned as doorkeeper at the College of Notre Dame in Montreal. He remained on this job for 40 years and was well liked by the students and their parents for his willingness to help. He also performed tasks as janitor, barber, gardener and lamplighter. Andre had a great devotion to St. Joseph, the spouse of the Virgin Mary and foster father of Jesus. People asked for the Brother's help and prayers for favours or cures and Andre complied, trusting all to St. Joseph. Andre was able to have a chapel build to St. Joseph, which after Andre's death grew into the great basilica of St. Joseph' Oratory in Montreal. Pope Benedict XVI canonized Brother Andre October 17th, 2010

O God, friend of the humble, You inspired Brother Andre with great devotion to Saint Joseph and dedication to the poor and afflicted. Grant us, through his intercession, to follow his example of prayer and charity, so that with him we may attain the splendor of Your glory. Amen.
