THE CONVERSION OF SAINT PAUL

Apostle



St. Paul, was born at Tarsus, Cilicia of Jewish parents, disentrance of the tribe of Benjamin. Paul was a Roman citizen from birth. He was sent to Jerusalem to complete his schooling. There he was educated in the strict observance of the ancestral Law. As a convinced and zealous Pharisee he returned to Tarsis before Jesus Christ began His public life. Sometime after the death of our Lord St. Paul returned to Palestine and because of his profound conviction and emotional character he fanatically persecuted the infant Christian Church. He took part in the stoning of the first Martyr, St. Stephen and in the fierce persecution of Christians that followed. The high priest entrusted him with a mission to go to Damascus and arrest all Christians there and bring them bound back to Jerusalem. As he was nearing Damascus a great light from heaven shone around him and he heard Jesus' voice asking him why he is persecuting him. Still known as Saul, St. Paul turned away from his apparent successful career to become a follower of Christ. He was baptized became known as Paul and became an Apostle and teacher of the Christian Faith.

God our Father, You taught the Gospel to all the world through the preaching of Paul Your Apostle. May we who celebrate his conversion to the faith follow him in bearing witness to Your truth. Amen.



January 26th

SAINTS TIMOTHY & TITUS

Bishops

ST. TIMOTHY was born of a Greek father and a Jewish mother. He was educated in the reading of the Scriptures. Timothy, his mother, grandmother probably embraced the Christian Faith during the first visit of St. Paul in Lystra. On St. Paul's second visit, Timothy was highly recommended by the Christians and so the Apostle chose him as a missionary companion. St. Paul sent him often on difficult and secret missions. During the first imprisonment of the Apostle at Rome, St. Timothy was with him, his master. After their release he accompanied St. Paul on his last missionary journey and was left in Ephesus to take charge of the Church there, where according to tradition he spent the rest of his life as Bishop. He was martyred, (stoned to death,) during the winter of the year 97.

ST. TITUS was a friend and disciple of St. Paul, who ordained him Bishop of Crete. About the year 56 St. Paul sent him to Corinth to reform the Church there. St. Titus was the most cherished disciple of St. Paul. St. Titus accompanied St. Paul and St. Barnabas to the Council of Jerusalem. This council insisted that he submit himself to the rite of circumcision, but St. Paul refused to permit it. St. Titus returned to Crete to exercise his Episcopal office and died there about the year 96 of old age.

Lord God, You filled Saints Timothy & Titus with apostolic virtues. Through their intercession may we live good and religious lives here on earth and thus be worthy of our heavenly home. Amen

January 27th

SAINT ANGELA MERICI

Patron of one of our Elementary Schools



St. Angela Merici was born in Desenzano, Lombardy, Italy on March 21st, 1474. She was the fifth of six children. Four of the children died young and were closely followed by both parents, leaving Angela at the age of eleven and her older sister orphaned. Together with her older sister she went to live with her uncle in Salo, a nearby town. There she lived a very holy life, trying to please Jesus, the spouse of her soul and was devoted to the Legend of St. Ursula. When her sister met with sudden death, without receiving the Last Sacraments, Angela was deeply distressed. She increased her prayers for the repose of her sister's soul. Imploring God to reveal to her the state of her sister, she was shown a vision that her sister was with the Saints in Heaven. When Angela was twenty years of age her uncle died and she returned to her paternal home, which she converted into a school, where she instructed young girls in the Christian religion. In a vision it was revealed to her, that she should found an association of virgins to devote their lives to religious training of young girls. She accepted an invitation to establish a similar school in Brescia. She recognized that disorders of society were caused, because the education of young girls was neglected. In 1524 she went on a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. On the island of Crete she suddenly became blind, but continued her journey. On the way back she prayed before a Crucifix at the same place where she became blind a few week before and received her sight back. During the jubilee year 1525 she traveled to Rome to gain indulgences. Pope Clement VII, having heard of her holiness and success as teacher in religion, invited Angela to remain in Rome, but she, shunning publicity, returned to Brescia. On the 25th of November 1535 Angela chose 12 virgins and laid the foundation of the Ursuline Order. This Orders object being the Christian education of youth, which she placed under the patronage of St. Ursula, patron of virgins. After serving 5 years as Superior, of the new Order, she died January 27th, 1540 with the name of Jesus on her lips. It was not until 1768 that a reliable account of her life was written. 1807 Pope Pius VII Canonized her and so added Angela to the calendar of Saints.

Lord, let St. Angela never cease commending us to your kindness. By always imitating her charity and prudence may we succeed in keeping Your teachings and preserving good morals. Amen.
