February 21st

ST. PETER DAMIAN Bishop and Doctor of the Church.

In 1007 St. Peter Damian was born in Ravenna, Italy into an extreme poor, large family. He was the youngest child. When his

parents died Peter was still a young child and as it was at that time, he was placed with his oldest, married brother, who treated him so cruelly, that his brother Damian, who was a priest took him in. Damian showed fatherly love towards him and had him educated. Peter showed his great gratitude by adding his brother's name, Damian, to his own. Peter Damian excelled in his studies and became a renowned teacher. About 1035, displeased with the scandals at universities, he resolved to join the monks at Font-Avellano. In 1043 he was made Superior and held this office until his death in 1072. His wisdom and sanctity was remarkable. He engaged in many delicate missions, which he achieved by his zeal. 7 Popes he served as advisor. In 1057 Pope Stephen IX consecrated, this humble man in spite of his objections, Cardinal Bishop of Ostia. Peter Damian laboured in defense of Alexander II against Antipope Benedict X, whom he forced to yield and ask for pardon. He settled discords amongst various Bishops and reconciled Ravenna to the Holy See in 1072. Days after he was seized with fever and after a week of illness he died in the monastery Santa Maria Vecchia, as the Monks, standing around his bed, finished chanting Lauds. 1823 Pope Leo XII pronounced St. Peter Damian a Doctor of the Church.

Almighty God, help us to follow the teachings and example of St. Peter. Placing Christ above all things, may we be ever active in the service of your Church and attain the joys of eternal light. Amen ******************


CHAIR OF SAINT PETER

St. Peter, after leaving Jerusalem, resided for seven years in Antioch before establishing his See in Rome. The feast of "Chair of St. Peter" was established to honour the dignity of the "prince" to whom Jesus, our Lord, committed the "power of the keys". This feast can be



found in the Roman calendar in the year 354. The date February 22^{nd} was considered the anniversary of the day Peter bore witness, by the sea of Tiberius, to the Divinity of Jesus Christ and was again appointed by Christ to be the Rock upon which His Church is built.

All-powerful Father, You have built Your Church on the rock of St. Peter's confession of faith. May nothing divide or weaken our unity in faith and love. Amen.



February 23rd

ST. POLYCARP Bishop and Martyr

We know about the life of St. Polycarp was composed by the Church of Smyrna. ST. Polycarp was very young when he embraced

the Christian Faith, about the year 80 and became a disciple of the Apostle and Evangelist St. John. St. John made him Bishop of Smyrna about the year 96. St. Polycarp governed that See for 70 years. St, Irenaeus was one of his disciples who recorded that St. Polycarp knew St. John and others who had seen Jesus. From Eusebius, St. Irenaeus and St. Jerome we learn that he was a leader of the second generation of Christians, the first Christians that did were not witnesses of the death and resection of our Lord Jesus Christ. Refusing to deny his faith, this Saint was condemned to be burned and died in the year 166, a Martyr's death.
