**PASSION OR PALM SUNDAY**

We commemorate the triumphant entry of Jesus unto Jerusalem. We see Jesus, our King, humbly riding the foal of a donkey, a beast of burden, to fulfill what the prophet Zechariah had spoken. "Rejoice heartily, O daughter Zion, shout for joy, O daughter Jerusalem! See, your king shall come to you; a just savior is he, meek, and riding on an ass, on a colt, the foal of an ass." (Zec 9:9-10) A large crowd took off their cloaks and laid them on the road. Others cut branches from trees and spread them on Jesus' path. Men, women and children lined the road Jesus traveled on. Others ran ahead of Jesus or followed Him, but all of them cried out: "Hosanna to the Son of David! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest heaven!" Today we still use these words at Mass. How fickle we humans are! How fast we turned on our Saviour and screamed "Crucify Him!" We do so every time we sin.

**THE LAST SUPPER**

Jesus knew that the devil had put it into Judas' heart to betray Him. Jesus "the teacher with authority" lowered Himself and washed the feet of the apostles. He did so to teach us how we should serve each other. Christ knew He would soon die and return to the Father. But Jesus in His great love for us left us Himself. He did this at the Last Supper, which He ate with His apostles; He wished us to remember Him. It was then He took bread and wine, simple elements of food, and declared that these when consecrated by priests would become His Body, His Blood, ever present to us. It is this Presence, this consecrated divine food, which we celebrate in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass. It is this Presence, this Eucharistic Gift of Christ given to us again and again, His continuing gift of love. It is the beginning of joy that will be ours forever. Christ gave Himself at the Last Supper, the most sacred and wonderful Gift that He could bestow upon us. We should gratefully welcome this Gift throughout our lives as we receive Christ again and again into our hearts; His Sacramental Presence should be ever before and within us.

**SUFFERING AND DEATH OF JESUS CHRIST**

Isaiah prophesied that Christ would suffer for us because of our sins. By His suffering and death, Christ offered Himself to reconcile us to God the Father. We could not return to God unless Christ came to earth to become a sacrifice for us as Isaiah said. Christ, our heavenly Gift to us, won for us grace and reconciliation with God the Father. It was Christ's death, the human destruction, of our gift from God that won for us the assurance of hope. It seems a sad and terrible way for us to regain the ability to attain our promised reward. Christ said, "Take up your cross and follow me." It is difficult for us to bear the hardships of life. But if we follow Christ, if we offer ourselves with Christ, we learn to transform the sacrifices and sorrows of life into pathways that lead to God. Without Christ's suffering and
