SAINT JOSEPH THE WORKER

St. Joseph, the humble carpenter of Nazareth was the support and watchful guardian and defender of the Divine Christ Child and His Virgin Mother Mary on earth. He gives dignity to all working people who do manual labor. On May 1st, 1955 Pope Pius XII proclaimed this day the feast day of St. Joseph the Worker and assured the



working people of the entire world, that they have, in St. Joseph, a shepherd, a defender and a father. St. Joseph is the patron of the working people and guardian of families of workers.

God our Father, creator and ruler of the universe, in every age You call man to develop and use his gifts for the good of others. With Saint Joseph as our example and guide, help us to do the work You have asked and come to the rewards You have promised. Amen.

SAINT PHILIP AND SAINT JAMES Apostles of Jesus

These two apostles, whose actual dates of death are not known, are commemorated on the same day, because a Basilica was dedicated to God in their names in Rome. Today we know this Basilica as Twelve Apostles Basilica.

ST. PHILIP was called by Jesus with the words "follow Me" the day after our Lord chose St. Peter and St. Andrew. He left wife and daughters, recognizing Jesus as the Messiah and followed Him. St. Philip is frequently mentioned in the Holy Gospels, we know that he was with the Lord witnessing His many miracles, and listening to His



Divine teachings. St. Philip was with the other apostles when the Holy Spirit descended on them. It is believed that St. Philip went to preach the Gospel in Phrygia, where he died. His body is said to rest in the basilica in Rome with that of St. James.



ST. JAMES (called 'James the Less' because he was younger than the other apostle James) He was the son Alphaeus and Mary, who was either a sister or a close relative of the Blessed Virgin, and for that reason, according to Jewish custom, he was sometimes called the brother of the Lord.

He is mentioned in Mark and in Acts, and is the author of the first canonical epistle. He was called a pillar of the Church. St. James died a martyr's death by stoning about the year 62.

Lord God we enjoy celebrating the annual feast of Your apostles Saints Philip and James. Through their prayers let us share in the suffering, death and resurrection of Your only Son and come to the eternal vision of Your glory. Amen.

Jesus Christ is our salvation, our life and our resurrection; through Him we are saved and made free. Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia.
