Jesus the Good Shepherd

We have many Images of our Lord Jesus Christ and each one of them helps us to get closer to Him and His Father. Who cannot feel remorseful for their sinfulness seeing the suffering or crucified

Lord? Who is not filled with hope by the image of the risen Jesus? Who can resist loving the humble baby Jesus in the manger with His mother, the Virgin Mary and her spouse Joseph? ST. FATHER DAMIAN OF MOLOKAI

Father Damian (Joseph de Veuster) was born January 3, 1840 in Tremeloo, Belgium. His father

sent him to college to prepare for a commercial profession, but as a result of a mission given by the Redemptorists, Joseph decided to become a religious and as such took the name Damian. 1864 he was sent to the Hawaiian Islands. On the 24 of May the same year he was ordained priest in Honolulu. He was a strong man, which allowed him to build several chapels with his own hands. On Molokai the Government kept a leper settlement. The afflicted with this decease were supplied with food and clothing by the board of health, but were unable to provide them with doctors or nurses. In May 1873, at his own request and with the blessings of the Bishop Maigret, Father Damian arrived at the leper settlement.



He did not just administer the consolation of religion, but also rendered medical service and bodily comforts as well as was in his power. He helped the lepers to build cottages, he built a chapel, he made coffins and dug graves. After 12 years of heroic service he showed the first symptoms of the disease.

.Father Damian's morality was called into question as the disease was misunderstood. He continued his charitable ministrations, till he himself became helpless. He passed away finishing 15 years of service to the lepers. 1905 the "Apostle of the Lepers" was vindicated and all suspicion removed from him. The insinuations rested merely on misunderstanding this terrible disease.

God our Father, life of the faithful, glory of the humble, You led Father Damian and gave him the zeal to help and look after the lepers of Molokai. Help us to see the needs of those around us so we too help wherever help is needed. Amen.



OUR LADY OF FATIMA

This title was given to the Blessed Virgin Mary after she appeared to three shepherd children in Fatima, Portugal, between May 13 and October 13, 1917, the three messages or "secrets" of Fatima stress the importance of repentance, conversion of

heart, find dedication to Our Lady, especially through daily prayer of the Rosary.

SAINT MATTHIAS Apostle

From the Acts of the Apostles we learn that St. Matthias had been one of the companions of Jesus, our Savior, from the day of His baptism by St.

John; for when the Apostles had to choose an Apostle to take the place of Judas. Saint Peter spoke:" Of these men who have been in our company all the time that the Lord Jesus moved among us, from John's baptism until the day that He was taken up from us, of these one must become a witness with us of His Resurrection" (Acts 1, 21) Two men were proposed; Barsabbas and Matthias and Matthias, who was one of the seventy-two disciples of our Lord, was chosen by lot. At this election about 120 followers of Christ were present. It was after St. Matthias became one of the Apostles the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles. Some legends state that he was crucified, but tradition that became incorporated in his emblem is that he was beheaded; this shows an axe superimposed over an open book in which the words "upon Matthias" are written. His relics were taken to Jerusalem and at least some of them were sent to Rome by the empress St. Helena.

Lord God, You chose St. Matthias to be an Apostle replacing Judas. Through his intervention may we enjoy the reward of Your love and be numbered among the elect. Amen. *****


