SAINT THOMAS

Apostle, Martyr, Patron Saint of builders and of India and Pakistan

St. Thomas was one of the chosen Twelve. His name occurs in all Gospels. St. Thomas was present at the raising of Lazarus. He was with Jesus at the last Supper. He earned the phrase "Doubting Thomas" when he did not believe the Apostles that Jesus was with them after His Resurrection and declared, that he would not believe if he could not put his finger in Jesus' Five Wounds. When Jesus appeared and invited St. Thomas to put his finger in His Wounds, St. Thomas' surrender was absolute and made the great confession "My Lord and my God". Thomas the doubter became St. Thomas the believer. St. Thomas went forth to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the Parthians, Medes, and Persians. He then entered India where he instructed People in the Christian Faith and performed many miracles. St. Thomas was condemned to death and was pierced with arrows.

Almighty Father, as we honor Thomas the apostle, let us always experience the help of his prayers. May we have eternal life by believing in Jesus, whom Thomas acknowledged as Lord. Amen.

SAINT ELIZABETH OF PORTUGAL

One of the patron Saints of Portugal and of Catholic charities

St. Elizabeth, known in Portugal as Isabella, was born in 1271. She was the daughter of King Pedro III of Aragon and of Constance, granddaughter of Emperor Fredrick II.. She was named the great-aunt St. Elizabeth of Hungary, who had died forty years before her birth. At the age of 12 she was married to King Diniz of Portugal. He allowed her to pursue the practices of piety, but did not follow her pious ways. Elizabeth gave birth to a daughter Constance and a son Alfonso. She cared and educated the illegitimate children of her husband. St. Elizabeth of Portugal, like her great-aunt, devoted much of her time to care for the poor and sick and the care of pilgrims. Diniz was known as a fair and able ruler, but was seemingly unable to deal justly with his own household. St. Elizabeth's birth brought forth the reconciliation between her father and grandfather; she often had to use her peacemaking skills to bring peace to the family. Hence she came to be called "The Peacemaker" Just after settling a conflict between her son and grandson, two warring king, she fell ill and died July 4, 1336 and miracles were soon attributed to her intercession Her cause was begun in 1576, and in 1612, when her body was exhumed it was found incorrupt. In 1625 St. Elizabeth of Portugal was canonized.

God, Author and Lover of charity, You endowed St. Elizabeth with the wondrous grace of bringing dissidents together. Through her intercession enable us to practice works of peace so that we may be called children of God. Amen

SAINT AUGUSTINE ZHAO RONG AND COMPANIONS

In the 19th century Christians were persecuted in China. Imperial edicts imposed the death penalty on all who attempted to evangelize or educate and ordinate priests. Augustine Zhao Rong was a soldier. While he was escorting a missionary priest from France he was converted and baptized. He then studied at a seminary and was ordained. In 1815 he and 119 companions, after refusing an offer of clemency if they abandon their Christian Faith, were tortured and martyred. Pope John Paul II canonized them in the year 2000.

Almighty God, through the intercession of St. Augustine Zhao Rong and his companions, give us too the strength and courage to stand by our Faith in word and deed. Amen

OUR LADY QUEEN OF PEACE

Tradition holds that in 1682 some merchants found an abandoned box on the shore of Salvador's Mar del Sur. Unable to open it, they tied the box on a donkey's back and set out to inform the local authorities of their find. When they were passing the parish church, now a cathedral, the donkey lay down on the ground. They were then able to open the box and were surprised to find that it contained an image of Our Lady holding the Child. It is said that a bloody struggle was going on between the inhabitants of the region, but when they heard of the marvelous discovery in the abandoned box, they put down their weapons and immediately ceased fighting. This is why the image was given the title of Our Lady of Peace. Also when the Chaparrastique volcano erupted and threatened to destroy the city with burning lava. The frightened dwellers of San Miguel brought out the statute of Our Lady of Peace to the principal door of the cathedral, and at that precise moment the force of the lava changed direction, moving away from the city. Pope Benedict XV authorized the canonical coronation of the image which took place on November 21, 1921. Her official memorial in the General Roman Calendar is on July 9 in the universal Church
