SAINT ALPHONSUS LIGUORI

Patron of Theologians

St. Alphonsus was born near Naples, Italy September 27th, 1696. He was only 16 years old



when he graduated in law and became a Doctor of civil law at age 17. After losing a case in 1723, God made use of his disappointment and called him into His service. 1726 St. Alphonsus was ordained priest. 1732 he founded the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer, with the object of labouring for the salvation of the most abandoned souls. This became his glory and crown, but also his cross. He laboured incessantly at the work of the missions until 1756, when he was appointed Bishop of St. Agatha. In 1775 broken by age and infirmity he resigned this office to return to his convent where he died after intense suffering.

August 4th

SAINT JOHN MARY VIANNEY

Patron of Priests

This French priest is universally known as the "Cure of Ars". He was born 1786 near Lyons, France. His parents were respectable, pious farmers. John often said that he owed all his holiest impressions to his deeply religious mother. Even as young child prayer was his delight and his mother saw his extraordinary devotion and wished for her son to become a priest. As 8 year old John was given charge of the cows and sheep on his father's farm. The French Revolution closed their parish church and so John prayed in the fields. After the Revolution John studied for the priesthood and was ordained in 1815. Three years later he was made parish priest in the little village of Ars-en-Dombes.

St. John Mary Vianney was a wonderworker loved by the crowds, but he retained his childlike simplicity, a true priest after the Heart of Christ. His days were filled with works of charity and love, he healed and converted and had time for everybody who came to him. He heard confessions 12 to 16 hours each day. Walking from the confessional to the rectory, pilgrims would be eager to touch him, cut pieces from his clothing and even his hair. When he died on August 4th, 1859 at the age of 73, John Vianney had already the reputation of being a Saint. Saint Pius X beatified him in 1905, and Pope Pius XI canonized him in 1925. In 1929, only 70 years after his death he was named Patron Saint of parish priests.

Almighty and merciful God, You made Saint John Vianney outstanding in his priestly zeal and concern for Your people. By his example and prayers, enable us to win our brothers and sisters to the love of Christ and come with them to eternal glory. Amen.

TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD

The Feast of the Transfiguration of Christ is celebrated to commemorate the manifestation of the Divine Glory. We know through the Gospels, that in



the presence of the Apostles Peter, James and John, Jesus was transfigured as He spoke to Moses and Elijah. As Peter offered to build three tents for Jesus, Moses and Elijah a bright cloud overshadowed them and the heard the proclamation, that Jesus is God's Son and the order to listen to Him.

God our Father, in the transfigured glory of Christ Your Son, You strengthen our faith by confirming the witness of Your prophets and show us the splendour of Your beloved sons and daughters. As we listen to the voice of Your Son, help us to become heirs to eternal life with Him. Amen.


