SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL

Priest, Patron of Charitable Societies

St. Vincent was born of poor parents in Gascony, France about 1580. He enjoyed his first schooling under Franciscan Fathers and made great progress. He was hired as tutor and this enabled him to continue his studies without burdening his parents. He studied to become a priest and was ordained in 1600. In 1605 on a voyage by sea he fell into the hands of pirates and was taken as slave to Tunis, where he was for two years before he could escape. After being in Rome he returned to France, where he became a preacher, but charity became his predominant virtue. St. Vincent de Paul died at the age of 80 in the year 1660.



God, You gave Vincent de Paul the courage and holiness of an apostle for the well-being of the poor and the formation of the clergy. Help us to be zealous in continuing his work. Amen.

SAINTS MICHAEL, GABRIEL & RAPHAEL

Archangels

Angels are spirits without bodies, with a mind and a will. They were created by God to adore Him, act as His messengers and guardians of human beings.



ST. MICHAEL, whose name means "Who is like God?", which was the war cry of the good angels in the battle fought in heaven against Satan and his followers. He is recognized as the leader of the forces of heaven in their triumph over the powers of hell. St. Michael is the protector of the Church of Jesus Christ

and Patron of Policeman.

ST. GABRIEL The name Gabriel means "God has shown Himself mighty".. St. Gabriel was the angel that announced to Zachariah the birth of John the Baptist and to the Virgin Mary that she will conceive through the Holy Spirit the Son of God. Communicating with us humans he is the Patron of Communication Workers



ST. RAPHAEL whose name means "God heals" is mostly known to us through the book of Tobit, whom he healed of blindness. He is Patron of Travelers.

God our Father, with great wisdom You direct the ministry of Angels and men. Grant that those who always minister to You in heaven may defend us during our life on earth. Amen.

SAINT THERESA OF THE CHILD JESUS

Patroness of the Missions

Marie Francis Theresa Martin was born in Normandy, France in 1873. She was the youngest daughter of five surviving children. Her parents were devout and quite prosperous Louis, a watchmaker, and Azelie Marie Martin. Her mother died when she was only 4 and Therese turned to her eldest sister, Pauline, as a second mother. When Therese was nine Pauline entered the Carmelite convent at Lisieux. After her sister Marie entered the same convent, she, yet only 14 wanted to join

them. Because of her young age she was rejected. She appealed to Pope Leo XIII. One year later she joined her sisters and took the name "Therese of the infant child Jesus". In 1894, after her father's death her sister Celine, who had to look after their father, joined them. We know a lot about St. Theresa through her autobiography "Story of a Soul" which she wrote under obedience. Only 34 years old Saint Theresa, after increasingly suffering, died September 30th, 1897. Only seventeen years after her death, 10 June 1914, she was canonized.

God our Father, You have promised Your kingdom to those who are willing to become like little children. Help us to follow the way of Saint Therese with confidence so that by her prayers we may come to know Your eternal glory. Amen.
